5 Rules of Retreats

- 1. **RESPECT**. Respect all people around you.
 - a. Respect your fellow Spring Retreat participants.
 - b. Respect your instructors and Spring Retreat staff.
 - c. Respect the Deerhaven staff and building. Deerhaven is an excellent retreat location, and we want to glorify God with our conduct while on their property.
- 2. **PARTICIPATION**. All participants MUST participate fully in all activities.
- 3. **LEARN**. Do your best to learn something new.
- 4. **FRIENDS**. Spring Retreat is a place to make new friends, so be friendly!
- 5. **FUN**. Above all, have fun and enjoy the week.

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About respecting the retreat rules:

In the event that a Spring Retreat participant does not respect the rules:

- 1. On the first instance, a verbal warning will be given by a Youth leader, along with an explanation of why the behavior was unacceptable.
- 2. If there are repeated instances, the participant's parents will be contacted using the emergency contact information provided at registration.
- 3. If the participant shows no improvement in their behavior, they may be removed from retreat activities. Spring Retreat staff will make the decision that is in the best interest of the retreat's staff, volunteers, and other participants.
- 4. Fighting: one warning will be given on the first day of retreat when we are explaining the rules of the retreat. Any fighting may warrant an instant dismissal from the retreat.

Valuable items should be left at home. Any dangerous possessions may be confiscated.
